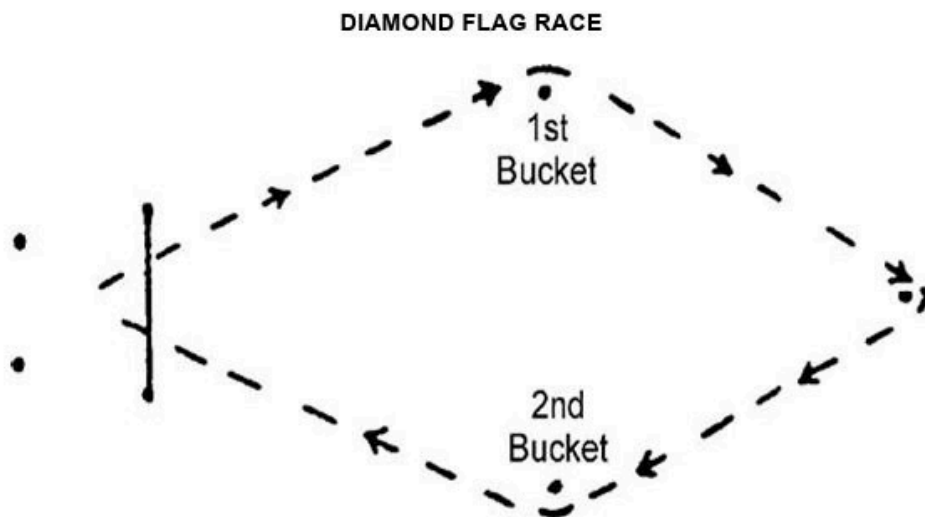




RULES: DIAMOND FLAG RACE



Course may be a left or right handed course.

There will be 3 flags each of a different colour. The standard for the Diamond Flag and the Bend Bar R Flag be 5mm rondo suspension wire (plaster company supplies part number 121), approximately 250mm long with identifying ribbon or flag.

Buckets on stands will be arranged as laid out in plan.

1 flag will be placed in each bucket, the rider may have a flying start carrying the third flag. He rides to the first bucket where he changes flags, then around the end pole to the second bucket and once again changes flags.

With his new flag in his hand he returns across the starting line. Failure to follow the course shown in the diagram will incur elimination. A knocked down bucket or barrel or end pole or dropped flag incurs disqualification. Flags must be placed in the sand in the bucket with the material end uppermost. Distances will be governed by the space available on the day. This is a timed event.

Any deviation from course i.e. step back or circling of the arena one or more times is penalized by the time taken and will not incur elimination.

NOTE: At State Championships the following dimensions will apply:

- 6m wide starting gate.
- 30m between start and end pole.
- 15m across centre between two middle drums.
