Samples will be collected by a registered Veterinary Surgeon and submitted to a NATA accredited laboratory

Keeping our horses hydrated is a year-round duty, however the risk of dehydration is certainly elevated when travelling and competing. Changes in environment, stress, and physical exertion can all play a factor in horses drinking less, or even "refusing" to drink when away from home. Knowing how to spot the signs and prevent the onset of dehydration is the best way to manage this risk, and thankfully, it is a simple process that any rider can carry out.

How do I check if my horse is dehydrated?

Skin pinch test

A skin pinch test is the quickest and easiest way to check your horse's hydration. Test by pinching your horses skin between your thumb on forefinger, near their point of shoulder. If hydrated, the skin will return flat in less than a second as it is in an elastic state. If they are moderately dehydrated it may take between 2-4 seconds, whilst anything longer than 4 seconds can indicate severe dehydration.

Capillary Refill Time

Horses' gums should be pink in colour and moist. Press your thumb on the upper gum for a second, turning the point light pink. When released, the point should return to pink within the second. A longer reaction time may be an indication of dehydration.

Overall appearance and behavior

Ask yourself the questions; has your horse eaten, are they alert and bright, and do they appear tucked up? Failure to eat, dull or flat behaviour, and drawn up flanks are simple observations that can be early indicators of dehydration onset.

What can I do to prevent/treat dehydration?

As a horse becomes dehydrated, the salt concentration in their blood decreases, and ultimately reduces their thirst reflex. Thus, it is important to stimulate the horse's thirst reflex, in order to encourage water intake and maintain their hydration. This is where electrolytes come in!

- Electrolytes and/or salt should be provided daily, particularly to performance horses.
- At a minimum, an electrolyte should be provided on competition days to replenish loss in sweat.
- In the lead up to travel, pre-hydrate by providing an electrolyte the night before departure, encouraging a big drink up before the journey where water access is restricted.

If you are concerned that your horse is suffering from moderate to severe dehydration, contact a veterinarian immediately.



A Proud Tradition: The History of the Pony Club Australia National Championships



For three decades, the Pony Club Australia National Championships have stood as a proud symbol of excellence, sportsmanship, and national spirit. Held every two years, this prestigious event brings together riders from all corners of the country to compete in a range of disciplines, united by a shared love of horses and the values that define Pony Club.

From grassroots beginnings to Olympic aspirations, the Championships offer more than just competition. They are a celebration of the camaraderie, teamwork and horsemanship that sit at the heart of the Pony Club experience.

The very first National Championships took place in 1995 in Wagga Wagga, New South Wales, under the inspiring banner "Towards 2000." With Sydney recently announced as the host city for the 2000 Olympic Games, the inaugural event encouraged young riders to come together, compete at a national level, and dare to dream of international heights.

Since then, the Championships have grown into a much-anticipated tradition, giving Pony Club members the opportunity to represent their state or territory, forge lasting friendships, and strive for the honour of lifting the Roger Braham OAM Perpetual Shield — a symbol of the highest team achievement at the Nationals.

Pony Club Australia recognises the investment and support provided by the Australian Government through the Australian Sports Commission's Play Well investment funding, which strengthens Pony Club programs nationally and helps ensure the continued growth, accessibility, and success of our community.




